


Truth Trackers is theologically sound, teaches apologetics, sets up a habit of daily devotions, teaches the same biblical truth to every group at the same time, and focuses on qualitative Scripture memory. The nightly schedule is very similar to Awana, so it will be a smooth transition.

Truth Trackers does an excellent job laying out what is expected of the kids in a step by step, easy to follow format. It has a daily devotion which helps kids set up the habit of opening their Bible every day.

The teaching material for the leaders is laid out in a much more usable format and will help with the consistency of the information being taught.

Awana has served us well for the past 15 years and we are so thankful for that ministry. However, Truth Trackers aligns better with the demographic of kids coming through our doors each week. It will bring more continuity to what is being taught and will help the kids understand the Bible and how it applies to their lives.

Our curriculum for the fall may be changing, but our ministry focus remains the same, to intentionally evangelize and disciple children.










24 High School students are heading to Camp Clydehurst in Montana July 8-15. Please be praying for their travels and especially for God to work in each of their lives through the week.
