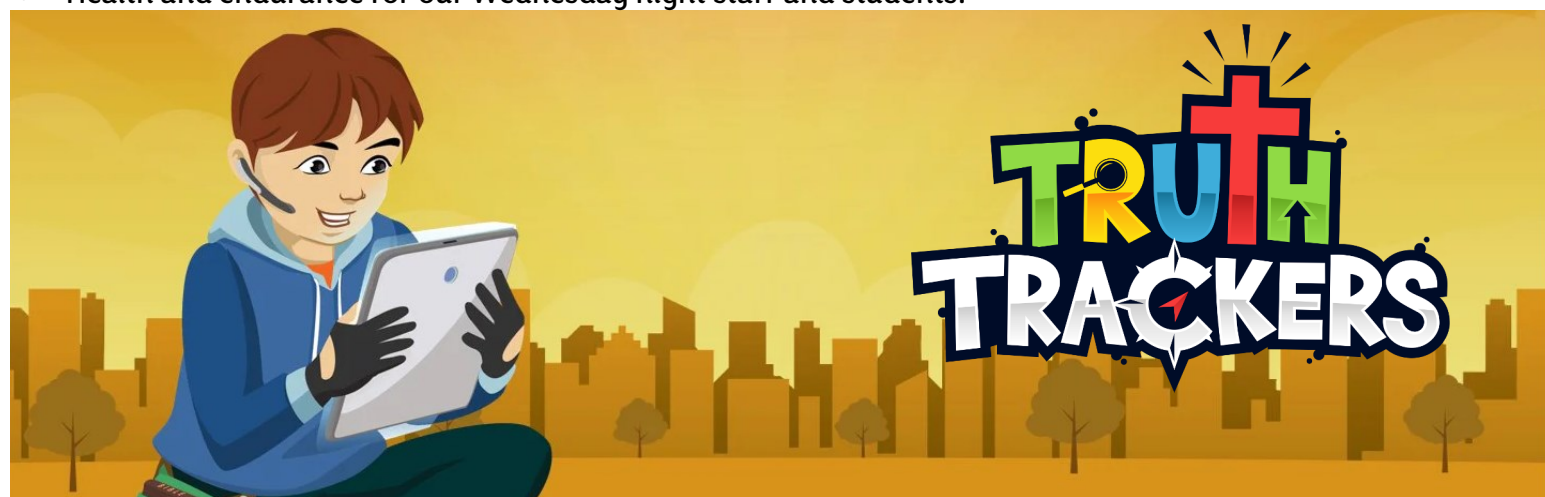

- Unity - team would work well together and build meaningful relationships.



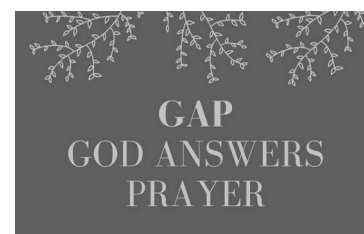


What are we made for? Jesus points out two main jobs of the Christian life: Love God and Love Others. Not everyone is called to full-time ministry, but God has wired each of us with a unique set of gifts, experiences and passions. With God in the center of your life, He can influence every decision you make. This is the missionary life. Now you may not ever go to another country, or even another state (though I hope you can at least once in your life), but God calls each of us to live as a missionary to the people around us. Here are five things recommended by CRU that might change your perspective.

1. Surrender. Are you willing to go, do, say and give whatever He asks of you, no matter the cost?
2. Vision. How do you fit into God's rescue mission? What part is God asking you to play? How can you use your time, talents, and treasures?
3. Team. Fellowship with other believers. Spur each other on, pray, plan, and achieve together.
4. Plan. God can use you when you least expect it, but see what simple, practical steps it will take to make progress toward the vision He has given you.
5. Equip. What people, training or resources will help you? You should always be learning and growing.
